Holy Family School Renovations

What was Done

- Replaced all the exterior windows
- New shades for the new windows
- Added two new fire exits to the dining room
- Added a fire sprinkler system to the entire building
- Replaced the Fire alarm panel
- Installed a new hood over the oven in the kitchen
- Air conditioning and ventilation work in the kitchen, teacher's lounge, computer room, and counselor's office.
- Removed the doors at the bottom of the stairwells
- New carpet in the second floor corridor
- New fire hydrant outside room 121

What the School Renovations Cost

While the books have not officially been closed on the project and there will be some money coming to us from Progress Energy for our new efficiencies, total project cost will be about:

Materials and Labor	\$613,546
Architectural & Permit Fees	<u>\$13,302</u>
Total Project Costs	\$626,848

The School's Annual Appeal paid for:

Four new exterior doors	\$5,410
1/2 of the window treatments	\$6,123
The hood in the kitchen	\$38,682

The parish maintenance collection paid \$1,938 for some additional painting inside our school.

An exact accounting will be given to the parish with our semester financial report in February
